What is orthodontics?

Orthodontics is a dental specialty that helps prevent and treat misaligned teeth. The most common orthodontic treatments include braces and various removable dental appliances such as retainers, headgear, and expansion appliances to move teeth.

How to get started

Your dentist can determine if orthodontic treatment is or will be necessary and refer you to a Kaiser Permanente orthodontist for a consultation and initial exam.

Coverage

The initial orthodontic exam is included in Kaiser Permanente's comprehensive dental care coverage.

Other orthodontic treatments, such as retainers and braces, could be covered by a supplemental plan to your dental care coverage. To find out if you have orthodontic coverage, ask your employer or call Membership Services (503-813-2000 from the Portland area; 1-800-813-2000 from all other areas).

How much will it cost?

The fee depends on how long the treatment takes and how complex it is. You can talk with a fee and benefits specialist about the specific costs and various payment plans available.

What to expect

- Initial evaluation with an orthodontist.
- Diagnosis and treatment plan (with an estimated length of time).
- Braces to align teeth.
- Retainers to help teeth maintain their new position.
- Regular office visits and checkups.
