Invisalign®

Looking to straighten your teeth but don't want a mouth full of metal? Invisalign® is a nearly invisible alternative to braces. It uses a series of clear, removable aligners to gradually straighten teeth without metal or wires.



Clear braces

Feel free to smile with clear braces, another way to discreetly align your teeth. They are comfortable, stain-resistant, and seem to disappear on your teeth. The only thing you'll see is a thin wire.

Teeth whitening

Want a whiter, brighter smile without the wait? Teeth whitening can make your teeth as many as eight shades lighter. White strips and custom trays are available for whitening application at home.

Composites

Composites are a natural-looking alternative to silver fillings that may be keeping you from grinning. These durable, tooth-colored fillings can often be done in a single visit.

Veneers

You don't have to live with chipped, cracked, or crooked teeth. Handcrafted veneers are thin porcelain tooth coverings that improve your smile. As strong as your natural teeth, they can close gaps and treat severe discoloration.

Implants

When restoration isn't possible, implants are a base for individual replacement teeth, bridges, or dentures. They are surgically placed below the gums over a series of appointments.
